5 points of a collapse framework

- 1. Damage Environment- deforestation leads to erosion
- 2. Climate Change- drought cannot sustain increase in population

THE STORY OF EASTER ISLAND

- * First occupied in 900 A.D., a subtropical forest of tall trees and woody bushes
- * Population of island reached @ 6,000 and 30,000
- ✤ Society divided into chiefs and commoners
- * Extreme example of forest destruction; whole forests are gone leading to a loss of raw materials, wild-caught food, and decreased crop yields
- ✤ This lead to fierce competition
- * In the 1680's the chiefs and priests were overthrown and the society collapsed in an epidemic of civil war
- ✤ When visited by the missionaries in 1864 the population was around 2,000 many more wiped out by small pox
